Students will also be asked to write down the equation they would use to solve the two-step problem. They will need to use a variable for the unknown. The first step will have parentheses around it. Example. $100-(50+30)=n$
*Reading Comprehension ldeas: In your Friday Folder, you will see a colorful grouping of papers. Many of you at our conferences asked about helping your child with reading comprehension. This packet will give you ideas of the types of questions asked in third grade. I have also given you your child's reading level.
